Firstly, I'd like to thank everyone who has taken the opportunity to have their say on the future of Orchard Park by coming along to one of the information events that have been happening across the area over the last few weeks.

Hundreds of people have attended the eight events that have taken place so far and given their comments on two options for regenerating Orchard Park. Feedback from the community at this stage will influence a Draft Regeneration Plan which will be subject to a further round of public consultation in June/July.

It is really important that as many people as possible have their say on how the area could change during this current period of public consultation. There are four events remaining and I would urge those people who haven't yet had the chance to attend one to come down, find out more, and give their views on how £160m of government funding should be spent.


Event details are outlined below and you are welcome to drop in at any point during the opening hours given:
